General yard work including mucking out, grooming, clipping, trimming, tack cleaning and general maintenance. Also assisted in exercising horses on the flat, lunging and hacking as well as having weekly lessons with qualified instructors. Also communicated with the students and parents relaying messages to the yard manager and ensuring they were happy with their horses quality of care.

Jays Logistics - Van Driver - February 2019 to August 2019 -

Driving a 3.5 tonne van delivering and collecting pallets to customers both private and businesses interacting with the customers and members of the team to ensure a correct and safe delivery of goods.
